

1ST THINGS 1ST

 This is the most universal of Hindu symbols and its sound is used in meditation. In Hinduism, the word "Om" is the first syllable in any prayer. More specifically, Om is used to symbolize the universe and the ultimate reality. Some people say that this symbol represents the three aspects of God: the Brahma (A), the Vishny (U) and the Shiva (M).

- As the cross is to Christians, the Om is to Hindus. This symbol is actually a sacred syllable representing the Brahman or the Absolute the source of all existence.






• Facts about size and Rank: It is the third largest religion of the world with more than 1 billion followers.

 No particular founder or holy book. Instead early Vedic tradition evolved into Hinduism.




- Hinduism originated in India.


THEOLOGY

 Hindus believe the soul (without body) is immortal and takes birth again and again.



NIRVANA

• Nirvāṇa is an ancient Sanskrit term used in <u>Indian religions</u> to describe the profound peace of mind that is acquired with <u>moksha</u> (liberation). In <u>shramanic</u> thought, it is the state of being free from <u>suffering</u>. In <u>Hindu philosophy</u>, it is union with the <u>Brahman</u> (<u>Supreme Being</u>).

- -Pantheism
 - •The doctrine that God is the transcendent reality of which the material universe and human beings are only manifestations: it involves a denial of God's personality and expresses a tendency to identify God and [in] nature.

The Error of Hinduism


•In Hindu thought, deliverance from such things is only possible through the doing of good works through endless cycles of rebirth / reincarnation.

- India is the most populous democracy on earth.

PERSECUTION

 Since May 2014, India has been governed by a Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) government, led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

PERSECUTION

 As a result, radical Hinduism, which was already present under the previous government, has increased steadily.

PERSECUTION

 While intolerance has risen, and minorities are constantly attacked, the central government has refused to speak out against the atrocities – thus further encouraging the radical Hindus to step up their actions.

PERSECUTION

 The level of impunity has gone up markedly for those who push for a completely Hindu India.

HOPE

•Like the apostle Paul in Philippians 3:8ff, they must look at all of their posturing for personal salvation, consider it as dung . . .

HOPE

• . . . and lay claim only and alone to Jesus Christ in His person and work in order that they might gain Christ. Cf. Matt. 16:24-28
