

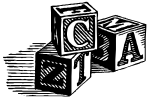

Basic Ideas from, "Understanding a Gospel-Driven Christian Life," Rom. 6:1-23.
The Holy Spirit is calling to us from this passage to consider three ideas.

1. The Holy Spirit desires for us to know God is the only one who can meet our needs and on whom we can depend.
2. The Holy Spirit desires for us to choose to seek Him first above all shadows.
3. The Holy Spirit desires for us to feel the joy of resting in His sufficiency.

9. Is my experience **in Christ** just as real as my experience **in Adam**?
10. "How Do We Get From Where We Were, To Where We Now Are" Or "How Do We Practice Our Position" Or "How Do We Walk In Newness Of Life?"
11. Why can the Christian life be problematic?
12. Is living the Christian life a set of rules?
13. What is the Christian life?
14. What does my Adamic residue cause my Christian life to be like?
15. Do you have "issues"?
16. Are you willing to have the Holy Spirit speak to your "issues"?
