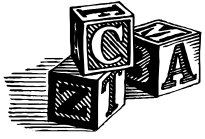

Response Questions for "The Beginning of the Gospel about Jesus Christ, the Son of God" - **Part 2**



Basic Ideas from Mark 1:1.

1. The intent of the Gospels overall, and Mark's in particular, is to show the person and work of Jesus Christ.
2. To see the beauty of Jesus Christ and to choose Him above all else.
3. To find our joy and rest in who He is and what He has done in our behalf.

Basic Questions from Mark 1:1.

1. Why were the Gospels written in relation to the larger body of biblical literature?
2. What is their BIG IDEA? What do they emphasize?
3. What is Mark's specific intent in relation to Jesus Christ and his immediate audience?
4. What place does Mark have in my daily life?

Basic Application from Mark 1:1.

1. Do you trust Jesus as the gospel?
2. Always see your life against the backdrop of the bigger picture.
3. What you and I believe is the good news of God for the salvation of His people.
4. Fall in love with Jesus Christ who *is* the gospel.
5. Study the gospels on a regular basis in order that you might know who God is and what He has done for you.
6. Where do we go from here? What is the next action step?
