Response Questions for "The Beginning of the Gospel about Jesus Christ, the Son of God" - His Baptism



Basic Ideas from Mark 1:9-11.

1. Mark's desire is for the reader to know why Jesus was baptized, and why they should be baptized.
2. In knowing the reason for baptism, his desire is that we might choose to be baptized by immersion.
3. Finally, in baptism the reader is to feel the joy of following Jesus.

Basic Questions from Mark 1:9-11.

1. What are your initial thoughts concerning water baptism by immersion?
2. What has been your understanding of baptism up to this point?
3. Is baptism important?
4. Why would you be baptized?
5. How important is it to work from a position-based acceptance rather than a performance based acceptance?
6. Are the workings of God based on our feelings or on His facts?

Basic Application from Mark 1:9-11.

1. Have you been baptized?
2. What would keep you from baptism?
3. Do you know the joy of God's unconditional love and acceptance of you because of your position in Jesus Christ?
4. What feelings come to mind when you experience God's unconditional love and acceptance of you because of Jesus Christ?
