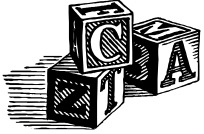


Acts 2:12 And they all continued in amazement and great perplexity, saying to one another,

Response Questions for The Gospel of Jesus Christ in Galilee - Early Galilean Ministry - The Servant's Ministry - His Authority Established by Diseased Sufferers (Mark 1:29-34)



Basic Ideas from Mark 1:29-34.

1. The Holy Spirit desires for us to know that Jesus has absolute authority over physical sickness and that He is always kind, compassionate, and good.
2. The Holy Spirit desires for us to choose Him as our Great Physician no matter what the outcome might be.
3. The Holy Spirit desires for us to feel love for the Lord Jesus as our Great Physician who is kind, compassionate, and good.

Basic Questions from Mark 1:29-34.

1. Does Jesus still deliver us from our diseases?
2. Should we pray expecting deliverance from disease?
3. Can all healing be attributed to God?
4. Think about the following material and discuss its application to you as a follower of Jesus Christ.

Basic Application from Mark 1:29-34.

1. In light of His absolute authority, what is your response to Him?
2. Is who He is and what He does just as real today as it was then?
3. How can you minister to the suffering? How can you be the hands and feet of Jesus?
4. Let us determine to be Christ to our community and offer to them a hope, healing, and wholeness that is only found in God.
