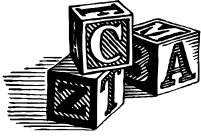


Acts 2:12 And they all continued in amazement and great perplexity, saying to one another,

## "What Does This Mean?"

Response Questions for "Why is He eating and drinking with tax collectors and sinners?"  
(Mark 2:13-17)



**Basic Ideas** from Mark 2:13-17.

1. The Holy Spirit desires for us to know the purpose of the gospel is to save sinners.
2. The Holy Spirit desires for us to choose to engage the lost for the purpose of fulfilling the gospel.
3. The Holy Spirit desires for us to feel the joy of living Christ to the nations.

**Basic Questions** from Mark 2:13-17.

1. How isolated are we to be from the social outcast and places where sinners congregate?
2. Is there a difference between isolation and insulation, between being "in the world" but not "of the world"?

**Basic Application** from Mark 2:13-17.

1. As a fellowship have we positioned ourselves to reach the sick or have we unknowingly cut ourselves out of effective ministry expression?
2. Are we like Jesus reaching out to sinners or are we like the religious establishment reacting against sinners?
3. We are calling the fellowship to several ministries whose sole intent is to be the hands and feet of Jesus in the company of sinners. You must give and go, pray and practice, learn and live Jesus. Be who you are where you are at.
