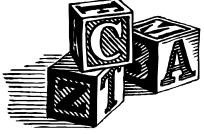


Acts 2:12 And they all continued in amazement and great perplexity, saying to one another,

Response Questions for The Sabbath was made for man, and not man for the Sabbath. (Mark 2:23-28).



Basic Ideas from Mark 2:23-28.

1. The Holy Spirit desires for us to know that the yoke of Christ is easy and His burden is light.
2. The Holy Spirit desires for us to choose Him and live in His freedom.
3. The Holy Spirit desires for us to feel the joy of living free.

Basic Questions from Mark 2:23-28.

1. What is more important to us, the saving of the lost or the maintaining of our image?
2. How far are we willing to go in order that the lost might be found and the gospel might be proclaimed?
3. Are we willing to give our time, our energy, our creaturely comforts, our physical comforts, and life for the glorification and proclamation of God?
4. When have rules made to help people been abused?
5. How do you honor the idea of a day of rest?

Basic Application from Mark 2:23-28.

1. The yoke of Christ is easy and light and His commandments are not burdensome. Are we ready to stand firm in the freedom of the cross?
2. Are we acknowledging the work of God to free people?
3. He is here in our midst working miracles, healing the sick, setting the captive free, do you see it, can you hear it?
