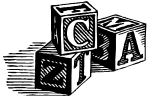


Acts 2:12 And they all continued in amazement and great perplexity, saying to one another,

"The Non-Negotiable -- He is risen; He is not here"

Read Mark 16:1-8



Basic Ideas from "He is Risen; He is not here - The Non-negotiable," Mark 16:1-8
The Holy Spirit is calling to us from this passage to consider three ideas.

1. The Holy Spirit desires for us to know the power and simplicity of the Christian faith.
2. The Holy Spirit desires for us to choose to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ and His victory over sin and death.
3. The Holy Spirit desires for us to feel the joy of living in the light of His life.



Basic Questions from, "The Non-Negotiable -- He is risen; He is not here," Mark 16:1-8

1. Why is the resurrection of Jesus Christ so crucial to the Christian faith?
2. Do you agree or disagree with the most basic elements of humanity's needs as noted in our material?
3. Is His resurrection central to the message of the early church?
4. Does everyone embrace His bodily resurrection?
5. Did those early disciples accept the idea of His resurrection prior to His resurrection?
6. What is the simple message of the Christian faith?
7. What is the simple mission of the Christian faith?
8. Who can you go and tell concerning His resurrection?



The **Basic Application** from, "He is Risen; He is not here - The Non-negotiable," Mark 16:1-8

1. Perhaps you know nothing of the risen Christ; then we invite you to place your life in His hands. He is the only one who can speak to and address your deepest needs. He alone can bring hope, healing, and wholeness to your despair, disease, and dysfunction.
2. Perhaps you know of the risen Christ, but you fail to "go and tell." Today is the day to start.
3. Perhaps you know of the risen Christ and you are one of those who consistently go and tell; if so, then let me encourage you to continue.
