

*“Lord of the Nations: The Character of the Comforter”*

*Isaiah 40:12-26*

I. His unlimited power (40:12)

Our God’s power is without outside restraint. His power is calculated not capricious. It is intentional not arbitrary.

II. His unsearchable wisdom (40:13-14)

God has never sought counsel or advice from anything or anyone created.

III. His unfathomable person (40:15-17 [cf. Prov. 8:15; Dan. 2:21; 4:32; John 19:11; Rom. 13:1])

God is Lord of the nations. Creations creator is creations Lord.

The constant theme of Scripture is that God rules over the nations of the world. There is no power equal to that of God’s power. He is the one who establishes kings and kingdoms.

IV. His unparalled greatness (40:18-26)

Notice please Isaiah 40:18, 25; 42:8; 43:11; 44:6; and 46:5.

In our quest to know Him we have unwittingly made Him in our image.
