Response Questions for, "You, Your Family, Your God and Your Church," (Misc.)



Basic Ideas from, "You, Your Family, Your God and Your Church."
The Holy Spirit is calling to us from this passage to consider three ideas.

1. The Holy Spirit desires for us to know our responsibility as parents in the raising of our children.
2. The Holy Spirit desires for us to choose this sacred trust and seek its fulfillment.
3. The Holy Spirit desires for us to feel the joy of trusting God to do what is always wise and right.



Basic Questions from, "You, Your Family, Your God and Your Church."

1. The most basic question is, "Are you patterning a love for Christ and His Church?"
2. Do your kids know you love without condition, accept without requirement, forgive without limit and serve without reward? How might you communicate these truths, this grace to your kids?
3. The most important platform for teaching grace to your kids is living grace toward your spouse. Are you? What does this grace look like in your marriage?
4. What can you do to create an atmosphere of faith within your home?
5. How can you take steps to instruct your child in the ways of God?
6. Is there an area of life that is so overwhelming that you are not spending enough time with your children? How might you correct this? Is it seasonal and temporal?
7. Are you using the shadow to speak eternal truths to your child?
8. What role might you play in your local church to enable and empower parents in their responsibility to raise their children?
9. What role might you play in your local church to teach children? The opportunities are varied. If nothing else, please pray for the parents and children of this fellowship. They need your prayers and your help.
10. It is never too late to show grace to your children no matter how old they are or how far they've veered. Today you need to seek God by seeking your child.



The **Basic Application** from, "You, Your Family, Your God and Your Church."

1. If you are not parenting your kids from a perspective of grace, confess it, repent from it and start. It is never too late.
2. If you are not relating to your spouse from a perspective of grace, confess it, repent from it and start. It is never too late.
3. Talk to your kids and open up lines of communication. Involve yourself in their lives. Create a context for communication. Preach Christ and if necessary use words.
