

What Does It Mean to “Bear Fruit?”

Matthew 7:13-27

Introduction:

In our prior studies on Titus, we identified the melodic line as “The Jesus Seed Always Produces Gospel Fruit.” But what is “Gospel Fruit?” In our passage from the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus illustrates the standards of His Kingdom and His people. He also gives warnings to those who bear false fruit and to those who would devour the sheep like ravenous wolves.

2. Good Fruit, Bad Fruit (v.15-20)
3. Self Deceived by their Own Works (v.21-23)
4. Build Your House on the Rock (v.24-27)
